



## ATTENTION PET OWNERS

The following is required by all pet owners that live in the City of Galesburg:

- All animals that are spayed or neutered and are 6 months of age or older are required to be registered permanently with the City and pay a ONE time \$5.00 registration fee.
- Fee is waived if animal is spayed or neutered and proof of permanent identification (tattoo or micro-chip) is presented when the animal is registered.
- All animals that are NOT spayed or neutered and are 6 months of age or older must register with the City YEARLY and pay a \$25.00 registration fee.
- All animals that are NOT spayed or neutered must also get their rabies tag at the Knox County Sheriff's Office at 152 S. Kellogg St.

Every owner must present a copy of the Knox County Rabies Certificate to register their animal with The City of Galesburg. You may come in or mail a check made payable to The City of Galesburg to the following address:

Those who do not register their animals with the City of Galesburg will be subject to late fees and penalties according to the ordinance.

If a pet is adopted through the Prairieland Animal Welfare Center, the Shelter will handle presentation of rabies certificates, microchip records, and spay/neuter records to the city in your behalf.
